Students Satisfaction Survey 2023-24

Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is one of the obligatory criteria set by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). It is also a pre qualifier for Assessment and Accreditation of the institution. From 2017 onwards the NAAC has endeavored to carry out a Student Experience Survey, the results of which will go into the accreditation process.

Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) regarding Teaching Learning & Evaluation was conducted during the month of July 2024 among the students through online mode by sending the Google form link to student's whatsApp groups. The questionnaire has been framed based on NAAC guidelines, containing 20 objectives based questions and rated on five point scale from 0 to 4. Highest positive response is rated as '4' and the lowest negative response is rated as '0' and received 462 responses from the students. These responses were analyzed by the feedback committee and reported to the head of the institute. The observations of SSS are as follows:


- Students were highly satisfied with the teaching learning outcome based on curriculum which includes continuous evaluation and assessment of students throughout the semester.
- Majority of the Students have expressed highly satisfaction over the syllabus completion in the class and laboratory experiments.
- Students were responded positively towards teacher's preparation, communication, and use of appropriate teaching pedagogy and fairness of internal evaluation.
- Students have expressed satisfaction over the illustrations of teachers for explaining Concepts through ICT tools.

The SSS has also pointed out few areas where the college/ teachers/ departments do have scope for enhancement in quality of education. They are as follows:


- > Institute needs to promote internship, student exchange and field visit opportunities.


1.How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 462 responses




2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 462 responses




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate? 462 responses




4.The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 462 responses



5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers. 462 responses




6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 462 responses




7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.


8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.


9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.




10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.








14.Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them. 462 responses



15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process. 462 responses




16.The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences. 462 responses




17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.


