- In order to reach this goal the institute has introduced certificate and Diploma courses sponsored by UGC, Karnataka University and Infosys under COP add-on courses, enrichment courses etc. Orientation and Training programmes for teachers have been conducted to increase their efficiency by updating their knowledge in respective subjects.
- Besides excelling in academics the institution has a well defined network for the extra curricular activities and sports. The various associations have been formed to conduct different activities to tap out the concealed talents of the students. The institution aims at creating future healthy citizens by recognizing their leadership qualities.
- All the activities both curricular and extra curricular were carried out as per the calendar of events prepared before the commencement of academic year. Academic time-table is strictly followed and the teaching work is monitored by the respective heads of the departments.

Computer has become an in dispensable to modern administration apart from this paper less office is a very popular slogan in higher education. Our college office administration is fully computerized with latest computers and software packages. As result the administrative work along with examinations is carried out quite smoothly.

During this academic year the college has installed latest software to ease the process of admission, attendance, allotment of Internal Test Marks, maintaining students profile, examination list and issuing study certificate.

26. Increase in the infrastructural facilities :

The flooring of the entire college building has been renewed and the class rooms are fitted with ceramic tiles.

All classrooms are furnished with new furniture's, desks, windows panels, and glass black boards.

Some of the classrooms are equipped with LCD projectors. Ladies waiting room has been renewed fully with false ceiling. Zoology & Physics laboratories have been renewed.

Chemistry lab has copper tube connection both the senior, junior and Physical Chemistry Laboratories with two units and 20 CPU gas cylinders. Good quality 143 LPG brass gas burners have been newly installed.

27. Technology Up-gradation :

Our computer laboratories were upgraded with latest TFT monitors and computers configuration. Each department installed minimum one computer set.

Our office administration works like admission notification correspondence are performed through the admission software.

Most of the staff members are conducting lectures using the Power Point Presentation with help of LCD projectors.

The instruments like polarimeter, electronics balance, potentiometer and colorimeter have been added to the dept of Chemistry.

Digital Ph meter and colorimeter have been added to department of Botany and Biotech.
